ANNOUNCEMENT

On 11th January 2021, the Government of Malaysia announced the implementation of Movement Control Order again in six states – Penang, Selangor, Federal Territories (Kuala Lumpur, Putrajaya and Labuan), Melaka, Johor and Sabah from 13th until 26th January 2021. For the same period, another six states – Pahang, Perak, Negeri Sembilan, Kedah, Terengganu and Kelantan would be placed under the Conditional Movement Control Order while the Recovery Movement Control Order would be enforced in Perlis and Sarawak. Following this, service levels of courier companies have been affected due to the cancellation of passenger flights between Peninsular and East Malaysia as well as the movement restrictions.

The safety and health of our members' employees and customers are our members' utmost priority at all times and our members have and shall continue to endeavour to implement precautionary measures pursuant to Covid-19: Guidelines and Preventive Measures on Postal Service Providers licensed under the Postal Services Act, 2012 as prescribed by the Malaysian Communications and Multimedia Commission.

The Association of Malaysian Express Carriers (AMEC) wishes to highlight that the implementation of restrictions and precautionary measures in place under the Movement Control Order as well as measures by other countries worldwide to limit the transmission of Covid-19 has caused disruption to the provision of postal services which are beyond the control of postal service providers. Due to this, delays or inability to deliver a mail or parcel are to be expected.

AMEC is therefore declaring a situation of force majeure until such time the Covid-19 pandemic is contained and transportation services return to a state of normalcy. Whilst our members will use their best endeavours and efforts to continue to provide postal service during the current Covid-19 pandemic and assist its customers in keeping their supply chains up and running, our members reserve the right to review and/or modify its services based on the prevailing circumstances consequent to the Covid-19 pandemic.
